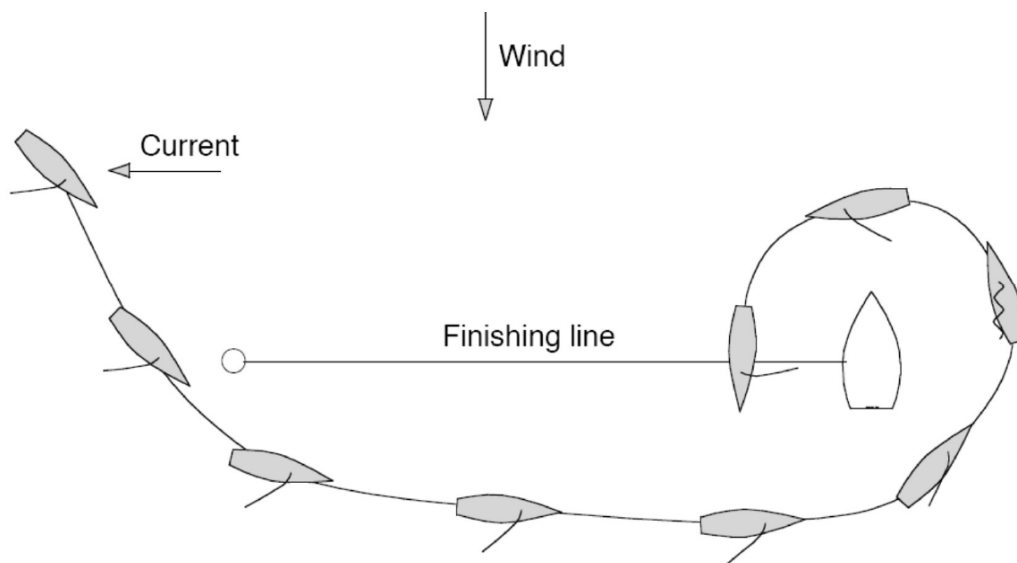

CASE 106: Definitions, Sail the Course
Rule 28.1, Sailing the Race

Question: Has the boat complied with rule 28.1?



Answer: Yes.

When the course requires boats to pass between two marks at a finishing line or at a gate, a boat complies with rule 28.1 if the string representing her track when drawn taut passes between the marks from the direction of the previous mark (see the definition Sail the Course). She complies with rule 28.1 even if the string also passes one mark of the finishing line or gate on the non-required side. In this case the boat passed the buoy serving as a mark of the finishing line on the non-required side before passing it on the required side.
